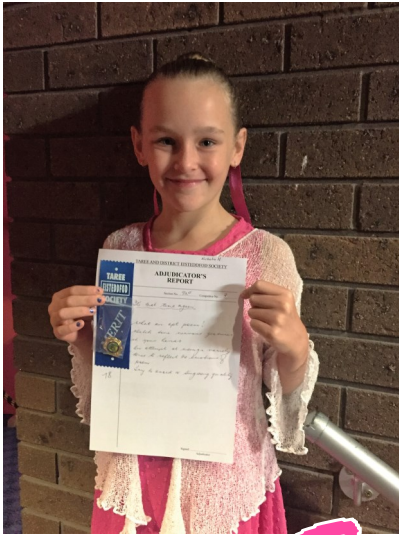
Soccer: The Soccer Gala Day has been postponed and will be held on June 29.

Debating: The VC debaters had their final debate for the term yesterday. They won, which means they have won the competition. Congratulations on a great effort.

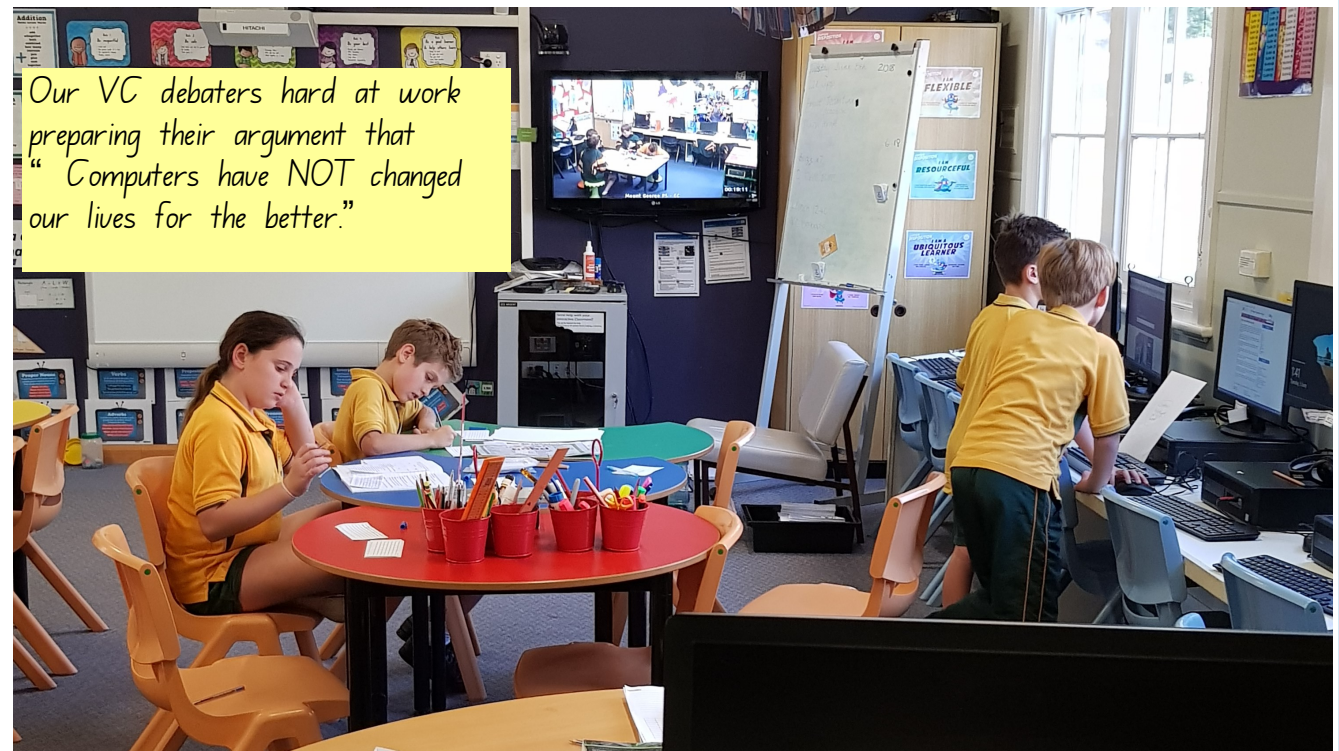
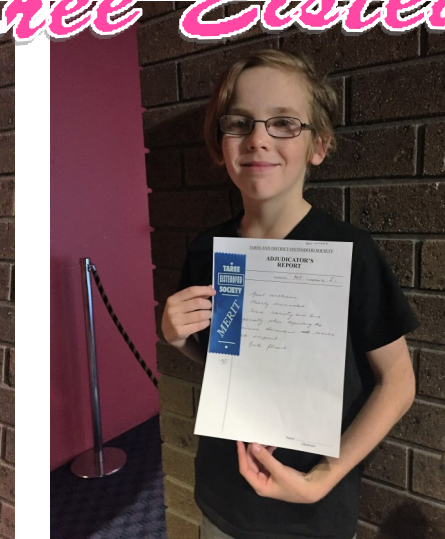
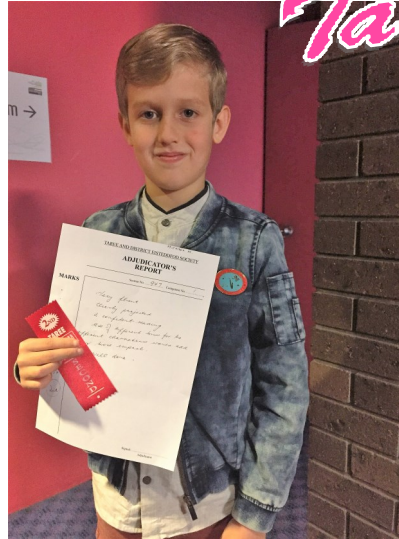
Bunnings BBQ: Thankyou to all the wonderful volunteers for the BBQ. We had a great day and raised more than \$750.00 dollars.
