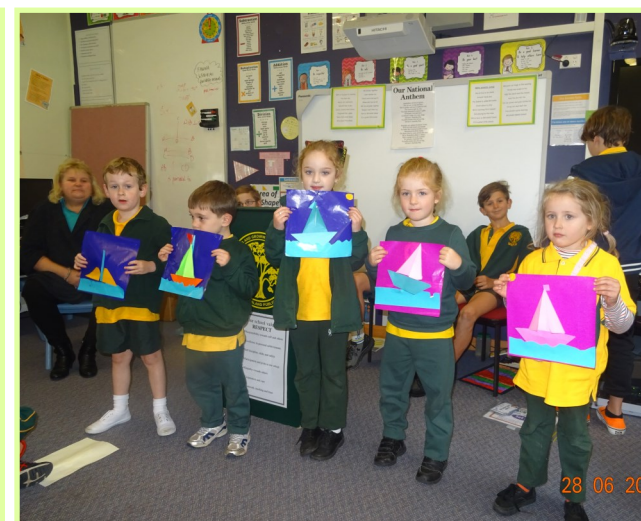
NAIDOC Day: Early next term we will hold NAIDOC celebrations at our school. Further information will be sent home next term.
