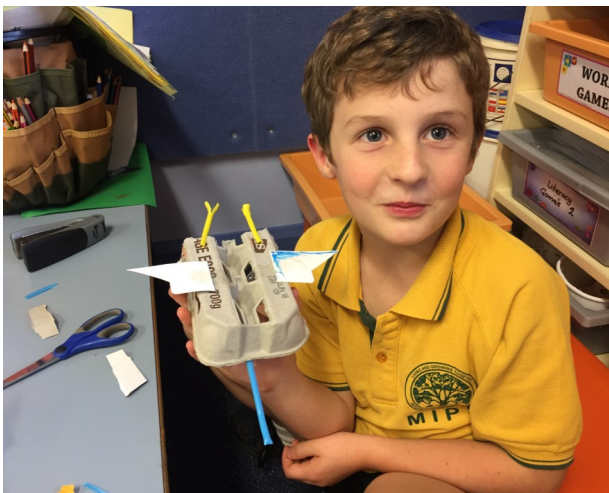
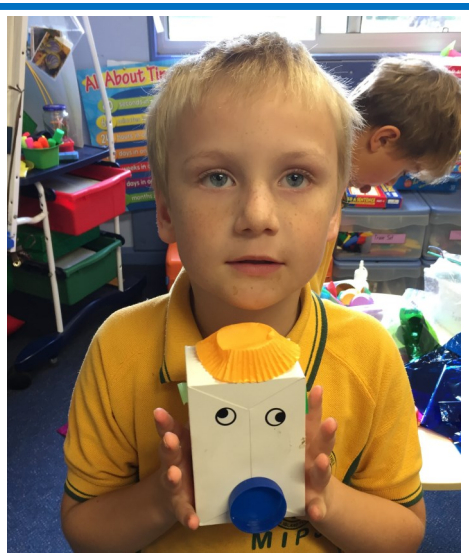
**George's Marvellous Medicine:** We really enjoyed the performance at the Manning Entertainment Centre today. All students were very well behaved and a credit to our school.
