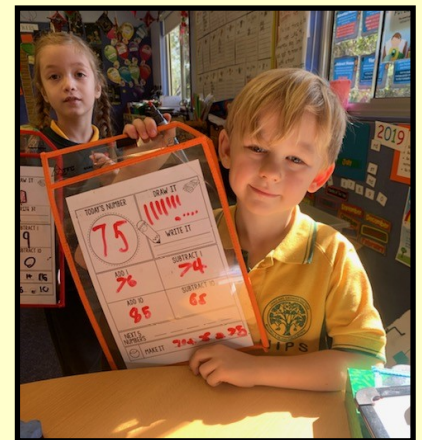
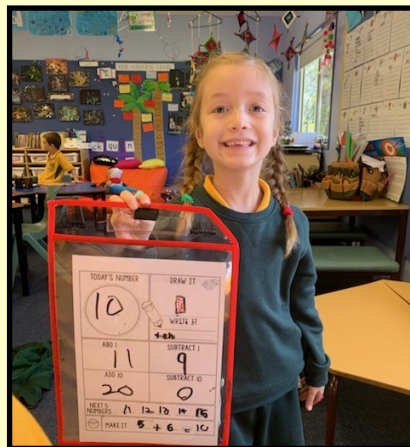
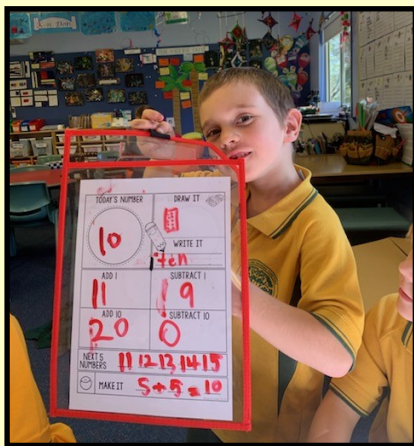
This week in K-2
